# Report on 17<sup>th</sup> VTU Youth Fest YUVA KALANJALI - 2017

As per the circular dated on 2<sup>nd</sup> march 2017, 17<sup>th</sup> Visvesvaraya Technological University (VTU) Inter Collegiate Youth Festival “**Yuva Kalanjali 2017**” was organized by Sir M Visvesvaraya Institute of Technology Bangalore from 16<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> March 2017.

Later on at 6:00pm we took part in the event named “Folk/Tribal dance by the Sir. MVIT students till 8.30pm and day was off.

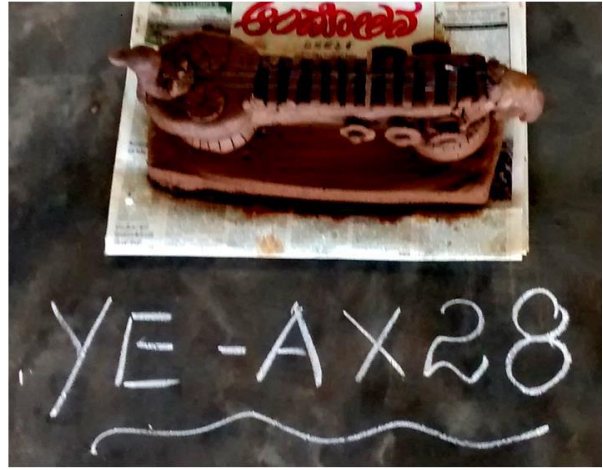
