

Universal Human Values – Classes – Induction Program 2021

The SIP is to prepare newly admitted undergraduate students for the new stage in their life by facilitating a smooth transition from their home and school environment into the college and university environment through various discussions and activities for

- Becoming familiar with the ethos and culture of the institution (based on institutional culture and practices)
- Exposure to a holistic vision of life (based on larger national and human good; or the well-being of all)
- Learning a creative skill in arts to express the larger vision of life (learn one art form like painting or music)
- Healthy lifestyle and ethical professional discipline (e.g. getting up early, sleeping on time, contributing to the subject of study)
- Overcoming weaknesses in some essential professional skills only for those who need it (e.g. Mathematics, Language proficiency modules)

As per the AICTE norms and VTU guideline SIP will be executed in two phases. Phase-I at the beginning of the I-semester for about 11 days and Phase-II of SIP will be conducted at the beginning of the second semester.

One of the main aspects of SIP as stated above is to bring awareness about the Value Education. In order to do so, Universal human value classes are conducted throughout the SIP.

Phase-I: UHV

In the first phase of UHV, Students are introduced themselves. Students were asked about their dreams, aspirations and goal of their life. Later They are allowed to think about the changes happened or observed in the past few decades. Students were informed to discuss the changes with respect to positive and negative changes happened in the human sphere and the overall impact on the environment.

Later in the sessions students introduced about the concept of Universal Human values (UHV). Also, students were taught about the four levels of Human leaving i.e., Self-Family-Society-environment. Also, problem associated with it discussed at all the four levels of human living. To better understand the UHV class, the students were informed about the word meaning which used at a larger context in UHV. The word meaning like, dialogue, Universal, Literate and Educate, Value and Price, Medium and Goal, learning and understanding etc.





Later in UHV sessions, Student aspirations, efforts and the ultimate goal of human life is determined. The students were learnt the ultimate goal of human existence is only lead a happy and prosperous life. The awareness is brought among the students about the real meaning of happiness. Importance of Value Education is discussed in the UHV Sessions. The difference between the Conventional Education and Value Based education is discussed in the session.

At the end of the first session of UHV, Value systems and different value systems were discussed. Gratitude one of the important values in the value systems are discussed. Students were realized the importance of Gratitude or feeling of thankfulness and how should we e thankful to the people with whom we interact in our day-to-day life.

Students were appreciated the efforts put forward by the UHV coordinators and given oral feedback at the end of the sessions regarding their learning and expressed that they have learnt lot about the importance of human living, value education and value system.
