









Report on Survey Camp at Melkote

As per prescribed VTU syllabus, Department of Civil Engineering organized Survey Camp for 6th semester students from 26th March to 31st March 2023 at Melkote, Pandavapura Taluk Mandya District.

The students carried out all the basic survey works in the field in prior to the commencement of any Civil works. Day 1: Town Planning

Students were assigned to plan a locality in a plot having an area greater than 1 acre by using Plane Table accessories.













Day2: Highway Project

Students were assigned to plan a new road alignment for a stretch of 1.2km connecting Kanaganahalli Village to Rampura Village





Day3: Water Supply Project

Students were assigned to plan the water conveyance system from Gowri Katte (source) includes intake structures, treatment units, Over Head Tank, Laterals and also Sewage Treatment Plant for Kanaganahalli Village and Rampura Village based on present and Future population forecasting method













Day 4 & 5: New-Tank Project

Student were assigned to Propose a new bund for a valley where possibility of collection of rain water, Capacity Contour for determining the water storage capacity and canal alignment for conveying the water to agricultural fields and for other beneficial purposes.















Every day students were provided with breakfast, lunch, evening snacks and dinner. Camp was winded up on 31st March 2023 and reached Mysuru around 11am.
