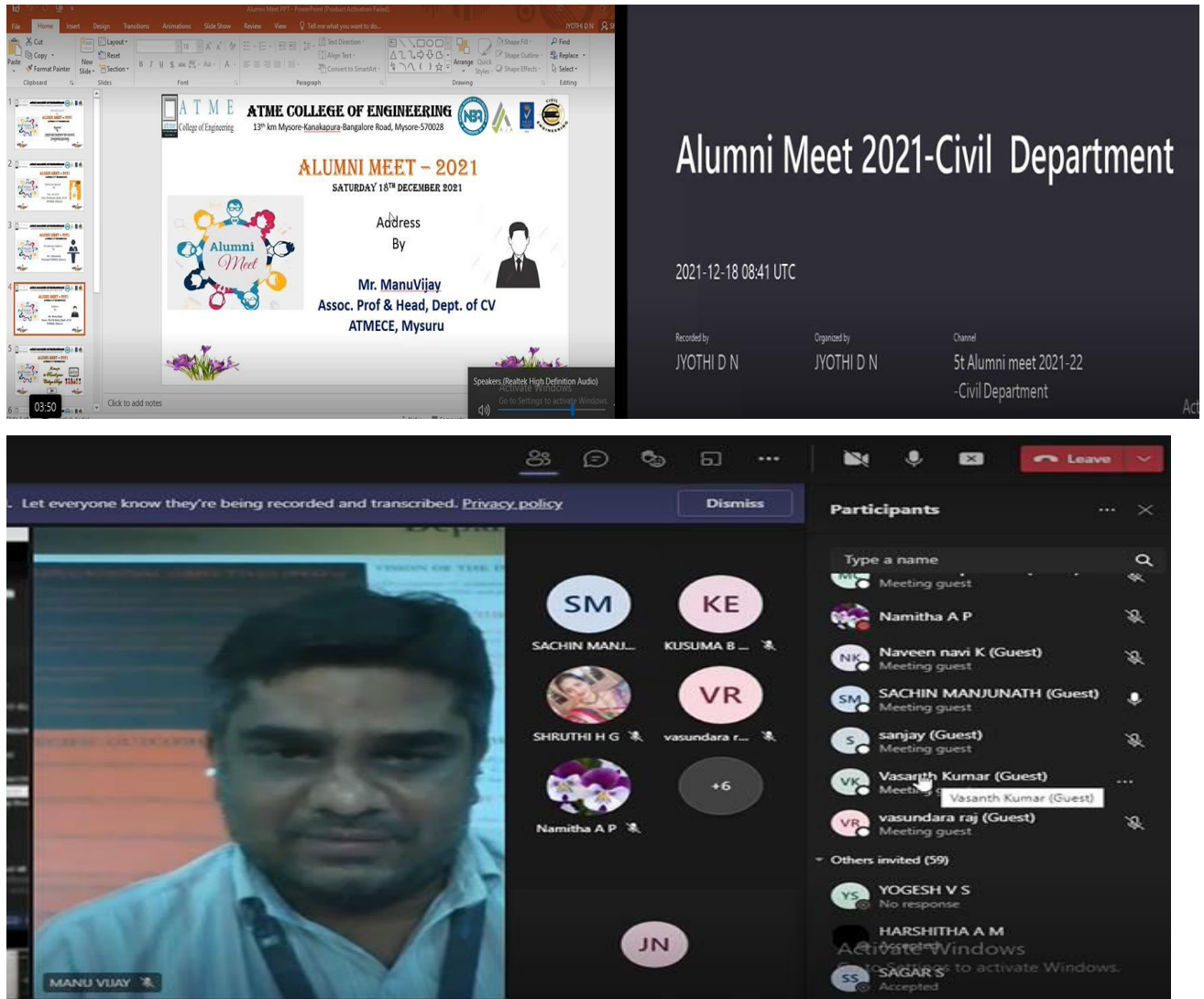
Mrs Jyothi D N , Assistant Professor and Coordinator of Alumni meet, Coordinating the entire meeting and interacted with the alumnus.

Finally, Mrs. Shruthi H G rendered vote of thanks and meeting concluded

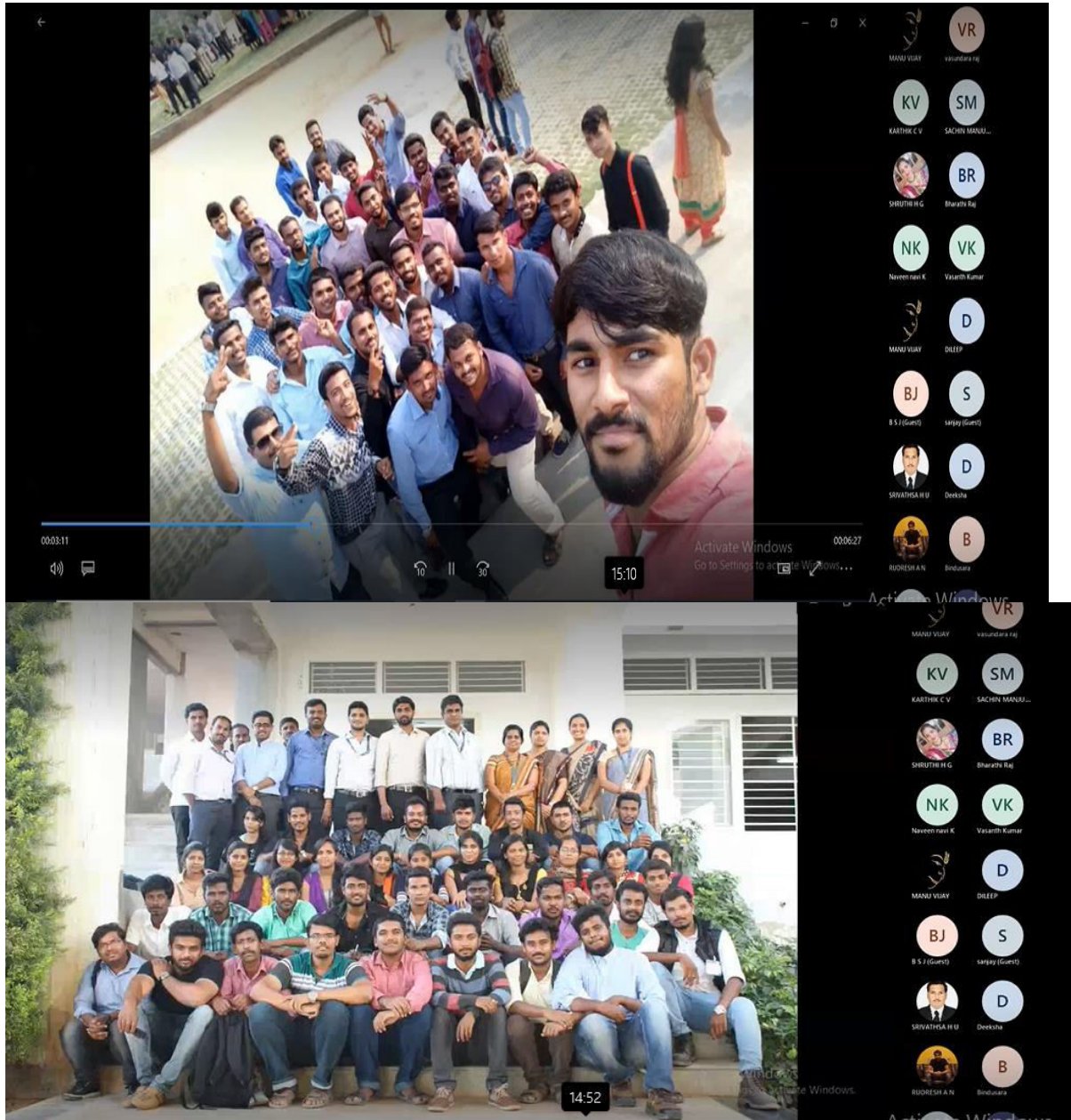

- Also thanked the alumnus personally for joining the meeting.

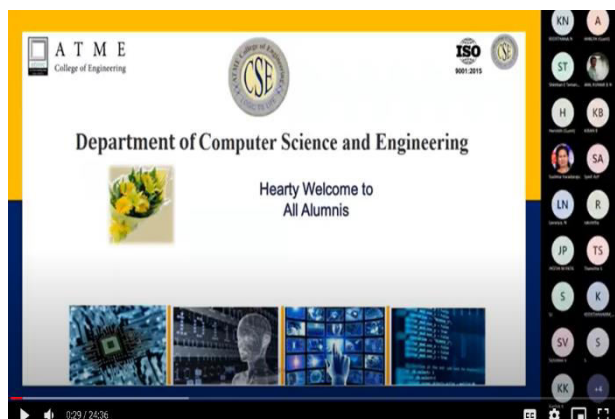


Figure: A snapshot of contents delivered regarding the department
